## City of Columbia Business License - Exempt Licenses

## Dear Business Owner/Owners:

Recently you inquired about obtaining an exempt City of Columbia Business License for your non-profit business/organization/charity. The required filing documents are listed below and must be submitted to our office for review and approval. Upon approval, a current year business license will be printed and mailed to your non-profit business/organization/charity. The license will expire on December 31 of each year and will need to be renewed by April 15<sup>th</sup> of the following year. All documents listed below will need to be submitted to our office every three years in order to maintain your status as an exempt non-profit business/organization/charity.

## Requirements:

- Complete a City of Columbia Business License Application
- Complete a clearance form (approval of the Zoning, Building, Fire & Health, if necessary)
- Copy of IRS 501 C-3 documents
- Copy of Secretary of State documents
- Bylaws or Charter documents
- Corporation documents
- IRS Form 990 (if applicable)
- Applicants complete name and phone number

\*If your non-profit business/organization/charity operates any for profit business, they must be licensed by the City of Columbia.
